Amnesty Facts

- March 16th-20th 2026
- Only Valid for Warrants Issued Prior to January 1st 2026
- All warrants will be recalled during this period.
- DWI, Synthetic Marj, Battery do not qualify for amnesty.
- Those that do NOT qualify for amnesty will get a new court date (DWI, Synth. Marijuana, Battery, and those in Tier 6 that do not qualify)
- Everyone will be routed to Violations for processing.
- Jail Slips that can not pay, will be routed to the Marshal's Office for community service assessment.
- Community Service will be offered in lieu of jail for those with 5 or less days to serve
- The average savings could be more than 50%

HOW TO BE MORE ACTIVE

1 MOVE MORE

Adults should get a weekly total of at least

150 minutes of moderate aerobic activity  **OR** **75** minutes of vigorous aerobic activity 

or a combination of both, spread throughout the week.

-  **BE STRONG**
Include muscle-strengthening activity (like resistance or weight training) at least twice a week.
-  **ADD INTENSITY**
Increase time, distance, amount or effort for more benefits.
-  **SIT LESS**
Get up and move throughout the day.

KIDS & TEENS should get at least **60 minutes** of physical activity every day.


